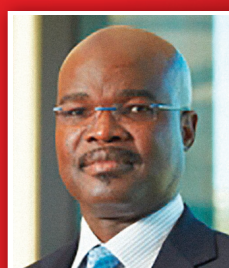
ANDREW CARNEGIE

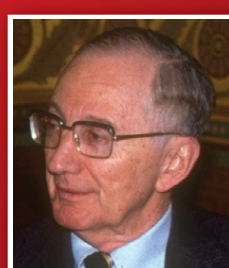

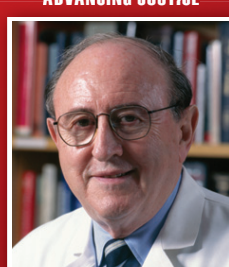

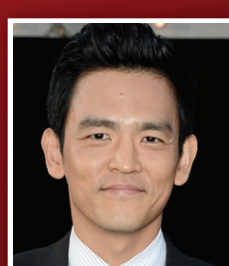
